The Council endorsed an agreement reached with the European Parliament in the Conciliation Committee on the 2014 EU budget and the financing of EUR 400.5 million to remediate flood and drought damages in four member states.

#### ITEMS DEBATED

#### 2014 EU budget and draft amending budget no 9 for 2013

The Council provided guidance to the Lithuanian presidency for the negotiations with the European Parliament on the 2014 EU budget and draft amending budget no 9 for 2013 which took place the same day in the Conciliation Committee<sup>1</sup>. Draft amending budget no 9 concerns the remediation of damages caused by floods in Germany (EUR 360.5 million), Austria (EUR 21.7 million) and the Czech Republic (EUR 15.9 million) and drought in Romania (EUR 2.5 million).

After the meeting of the Conciliation Committee the Council endorsed the compromise reached. The agreement is expected to be formally adopted by the Council on 19 November and by the European Parliament on 20 November.
