The Council adopted a political agreement on the Directive proposal above.

**2. Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) No 260/2012 as regards the migration to Union-wide credit transfers and direct debits [First reading] (LA+S)**

PE-CONS 9/14 EF 12 ECOFIN 34 CONSOM 11

The Council approved the amendment set out in the European Parliament's position at first reading and adopted the proposed act amended accordingly, pursuant to Article 294(4) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union. (Legal basis: Article 114 of the TFEU).

### **Statement by the UK**

"While the UK has no policy objection to the proposed Regulation, the UK is concerned by the approach taken to this urgent quick fix legislative proposal. Member States should have been informed of the Commission's intention to postpone the implementation date ahead of its publication. National parliaments should be given appropriate time to scrutinize EU legislative proposals. The timetabling that was initially pursued on this proposal would not have allowed for this."
