<u>The Council</u> had a discussion on the state of play on the abovementioned regulation where 25 Member States took the floor.

Following the discussion, <u>the President of the Council</u> concluded that the debate clarified the different positions of the Member States and that the possibilities to find a compromise had been exhausted. <u>The Presidency</u> stated that it did not have the intention to seek for a new compromise until the end of the mandate.

<u>The Council</u> had a brief discussion on the state of play on the abovementioned regulation where the President of the Council acknowledged that despite strong efforts made by the Presidency, no consensus had emerged on the compromise proposal at technical level. <u>The Presidency</u> invited the Commission and Member States to reflect on possible alternative instruments, since the Council has exhausted all negotiating opportunities on this legislative file.
