ANNEX II: Additional support for Greece to be provided by Commission and EU Agencies

Fully implement the "hotspots" <i>Council Rec: 5, 7, 9</i> <i>Commission Rec: 5</i>	Commission experts and Frontex to step up support to Greece in the implementation of the hotspot approach and of the relocation scheme. ²
	On the basis of Greece's needs assessment (once received), Commission and Frontex to examine together with Greece the Greek national programme under the Internal Security Fund in order to reprioritise and/or revise the programme if needed by end of March to ensure the necessary systematic checks of all migrants against the relevant databases.
Ensure fingerprinting in Eurodac of all migrants who arrived irregularly <i>Council Rec: 6, 7, 9, 40</i> <i>Commission Rec: 6</i>	Commission and eu-LISA to support Greece in fixing the software bug by end of March to avoid a system breakdown, followed by a full upgrade of the underlying IT system.
	On the basis of Greece's needs assessment (once received), Commission to examine together with Greece the Greek national programme under the Internal Security Fund in order to reprioritise and/or revise the programme if needed by end of March concerning the resources for technical equipment.
Immediately launch return procedures <i>Council Rec: 10</i> <i>Commission Rec: 12</i>	In order to urgently implement the new programme of support on flexible operational activities on return, Greece and Frontex to identify the needs by 15 March.
	Commission to examine together with Greece the existing funding possibilities for return within Greece's national programme under the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund.
Ensure sufficient patrolling activities at sea/sea border surveillance <i>Council Rec: 13,</i> <i>Commission Rec: 2</i>	Frontex to immediately assess Greece's needs assessment (once received) to prepare the further deployment of European Border Guard Teams, and if needed to launch additional calls for contributions by 22 March at the latest.
Ensure that third country nationals can only leave the territory of Greece at designated border crossing points <i>Council Rec: 1, 9, 10, 50</i> <i>Commission Rec: 4e</i>	Frontex to immediately assess Greece's needs assessment (once received) to prepare the further deployment of European Border Guard Teams, and if needed to launch additional calls for contributions by 22 March at the latest.
Make full and efficient use of the existing European funds for implementing the recommendations <i>Commission Rec: 13</i>	On the basis of Greece's needs assessment (once received), Commission to examine together with Greece the its national programmes under the Internal Security Fund and the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund in order to reprioritise and/or revise the programme if needed by end of March (see above).
