### THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Regulation (EC, Euratom) N°1605/2002<sup>1</sup> and in particular Article 19 thereof.

#### Whereas:

- (1) On 29 August 2006, the association An Gum established at 24-27 North Frederick Street, Dublin 1, stated its intention of providing the Commission's Directorate-General for Translation with five publications to facilitate translation into Irish.
- (2) Under Regulation (EC) No 920/2005<sup>2</sup>, the Irish language became an official language of the European Union on 1 January 2007.
- (3) Accepting this donation does not entail any charges,

#### HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

#### Article 1

On behalf of the European Communities, the Commission hereby accepts the gift from An Gúm of five copies of different publications in the Irish language to facilitate translation work.

## Article 2

The publications referred to in Article 1 shall be entered in the inventory of the Directorate-General for Translation.
