



EFFICIENCY- MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL SYSTEM

- A sustainable MCS has been created;
- Low percentage of financial corrections –
 1.59% of the total amount paid under the
 SCF as of 31.10.2012 (Certifying Authority
 data);
- Low error rate in financial terms in the OPs

 well below the admissible 2% materiality
 threshold (Audit Authority data);
- No OPs "stopped"- Bulgaria, Finland, Sweden and Denmark.

EFFICIENCY – ADECUATE INSTITUTIONAL AND LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK

- Capacity building of the institutions and beneficiaries;
- Partnership and dialogue with the stakeholders;
- Legal framework changes;
- E-application and project reporting;



OPT	Sofia Metro – Stages 1 and 2	13 metro stations, 13,2 km metro lines, 300 000 passengers daily; intermodality;
OPE	Integrated investment proj ect for improvement of Hisarya water sector	200 000 citizens with better water infrastructure; over 188 000 CO2 emissions saved for the next 30 years;
OPRD	Sofia Ring Road's Southern Arc	More than 1.1 million people use modernized urban environment – over 500 000 $\rm m^2$; more than 1.5 million people use the 382 modernized buildings; better educational infrastructure for 173 schools where 33 800 pupils study;
OPC	Holcim Bulgaria JSC	Increasing the beneficiaries' production capacity by 34,5%;

GENERAL CONCLUSIONS - EFFECT

- 1. EU Funds 60% of the total public investments; 60% of the 7 OP's financial resource allocated to growth-related measures and job creation;
- 2. Multiplying effect: 1€ of the SCF creates 1,21 €;
- 3. Need for an objective analysis and realistic indicators in the programming process;
- 4. Need for flexibility and integrated approach in the implementation of the sectoral policies and reforms;
- 5. Effective Cohesion Policy coordinated and integrated framework of the different sectors;

GENERAL CONCLUSIONS - EFFECT(2)

- 6. Need for analysis at the level of a single project for assessment of the investment effectiveness;
- 7. Boosting effects by reduction of administrative burden;
- 8. Avoiding "Projects for projects" "Art for art";
- 9. Avoiding "paradox of the good choice" focus on the quality achieved, not quality declared;
- 10.Increasing institutional capacity of the local administrations.

Recommendations for the new Programming period (2014-2020) in Bulgaria

CEAOEF recommends:

- 1. A thorough analysis of the progress made under the performance indicators;
- 2. Analysis of the mistakes and the legislative changes;
- 3. Preparation of a "Manual of good practices" from the first Programming period;
- 4. Implementation of "e-Cohesion" 2014-2020;
- 5. Avoidance of the "late start" risk;

Recommendations for the new Programming period (2014-2020) in Bulgaria

- 6. Clear line of demarcation and overcoming the risk of "white spots";
- 7. Integrated approach towards territorial development;
- 8. Building of adequate regional infrastructure in Southeast Europe;
- 9. Cohesion policy: investment policy for intelligent, ecological and inclusive development;
- 10. "Intelligent Solidarity".

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
